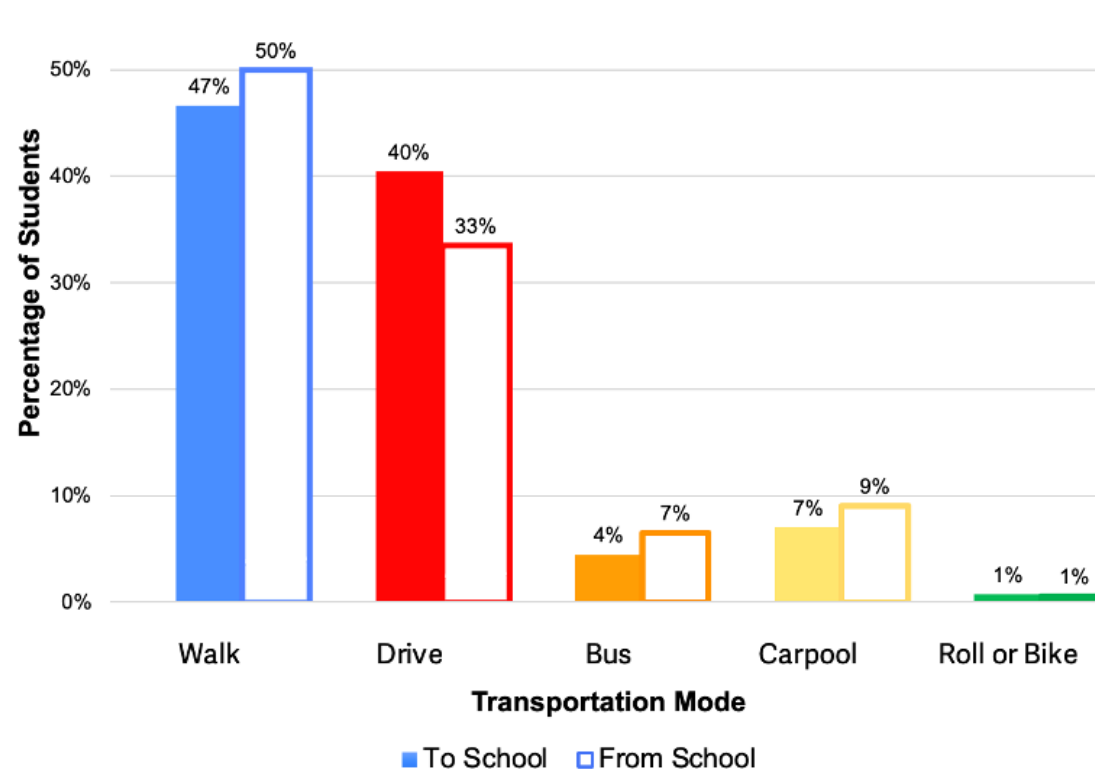


Figure 1: How K-5 Students Travel to and from School



On average, almost half of all students walk TO school (47%) compared to walking FROM school (50%). While the variation between the average percentage of students who walk TO versus FROM SCHOOL, individual schools show great variation in various modes used to travel TO school versus FROM school. (See Figure 4A versus 4B for individual schools.)

On average, 40% of K-5 students are driven TO school, whereas 33% are driven FROM school, a 21% relative decrease. (Again, see Figures 4A versus 4B for more details.)



Figure 2: Transportation K-5 Students Would Like to Try

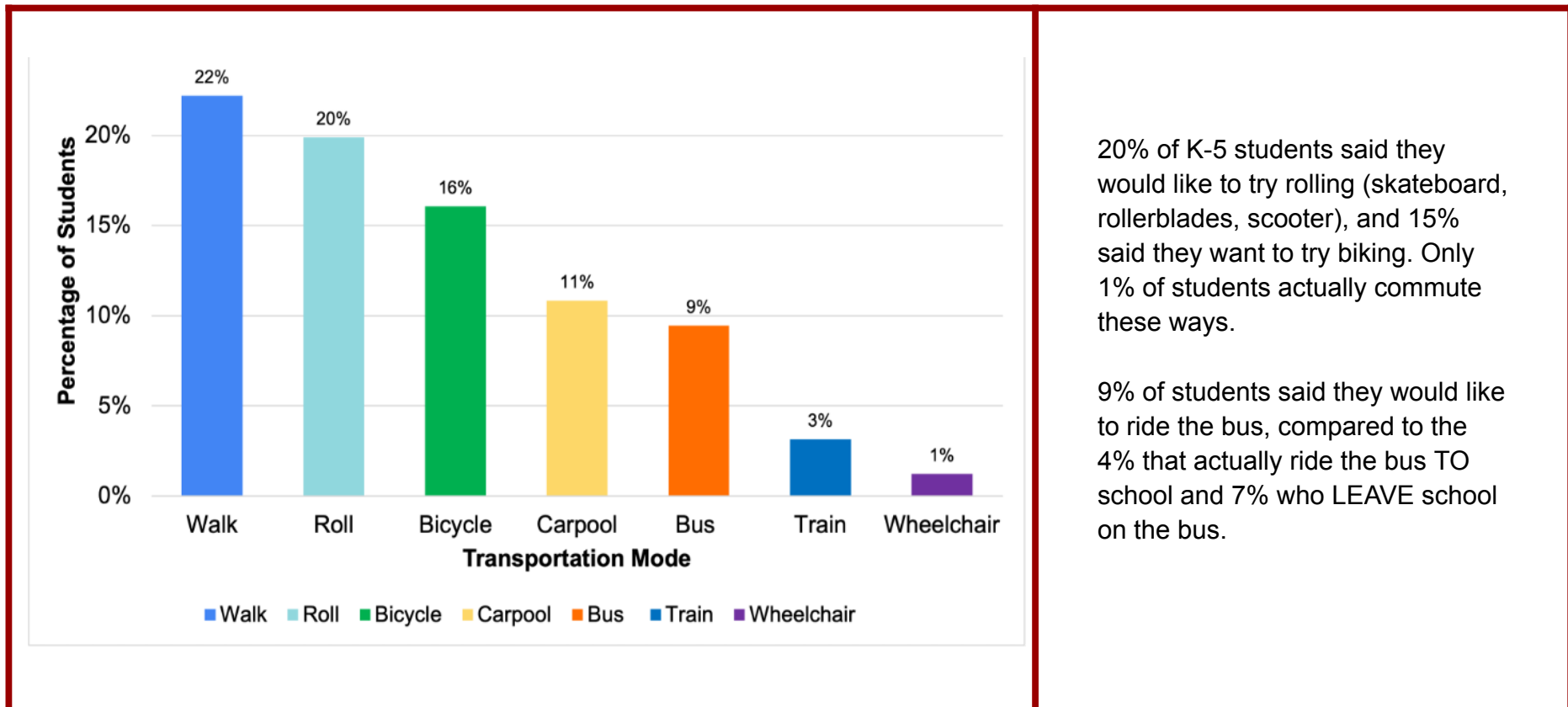
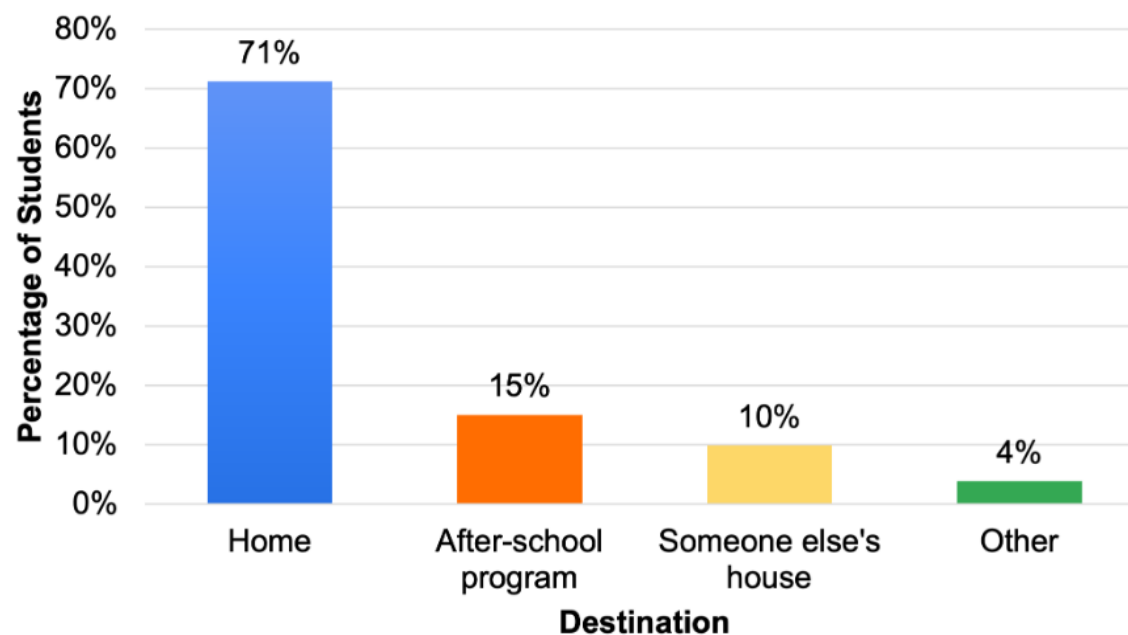


Figure 3: Where K-5 Students Go After School



15% of K-5 students attend an after-school program after school, compared to 5% of middle schoolers and 11% of high schoolers.

Over 70% of K-5 students go home after school.

Figure 4A: K-5 Commute TO School by School

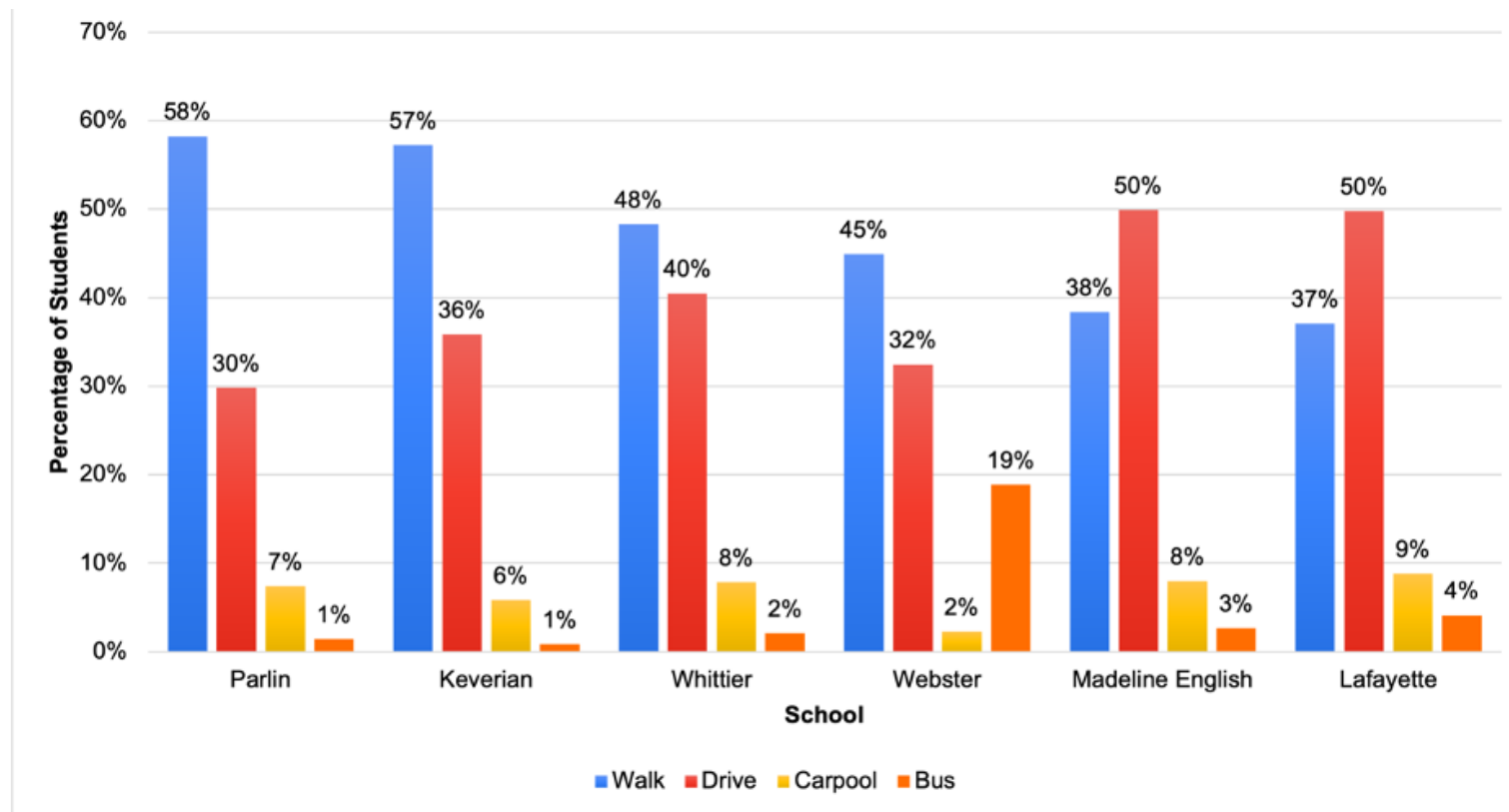


Figure 4B: K-5 Commute FROM School by School

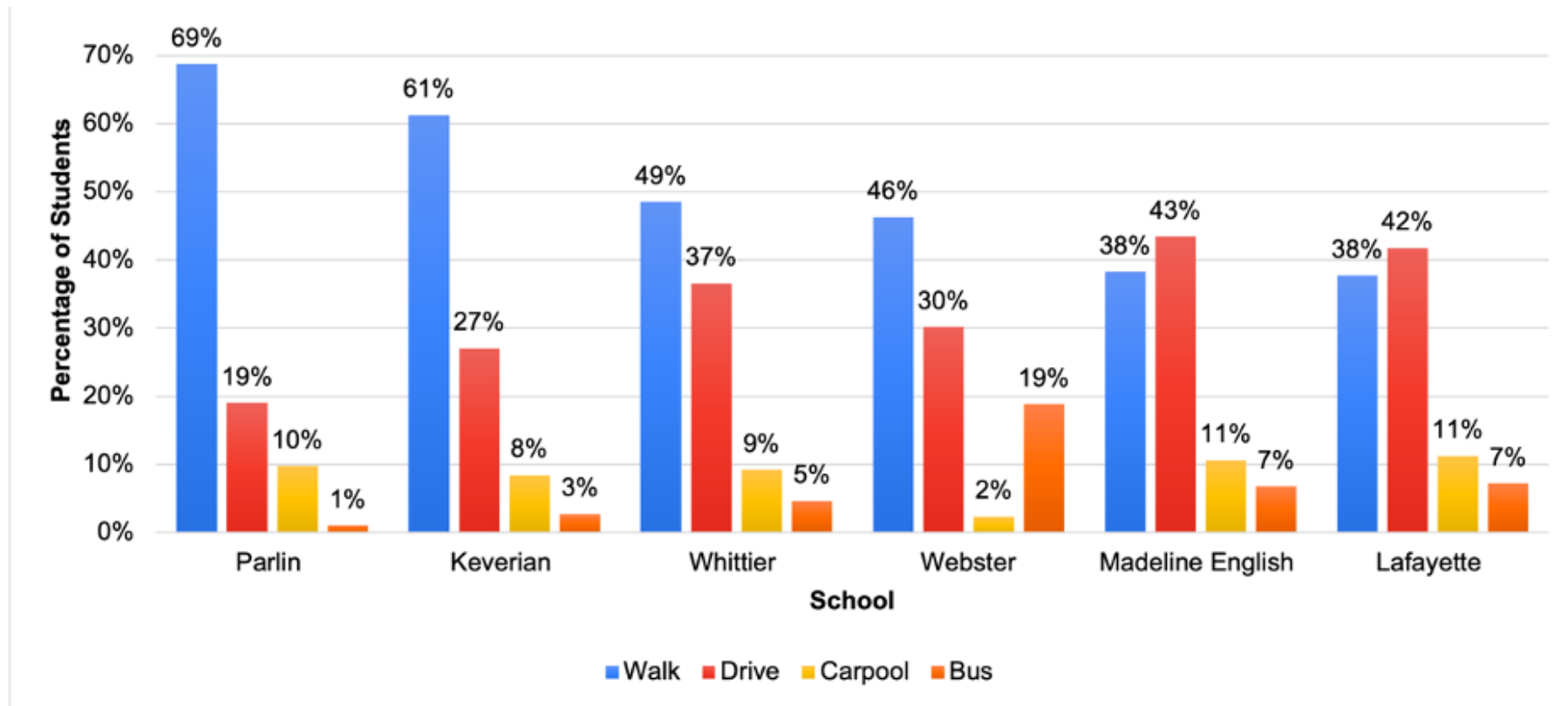


Figure 4C: K-5 After-School Destination

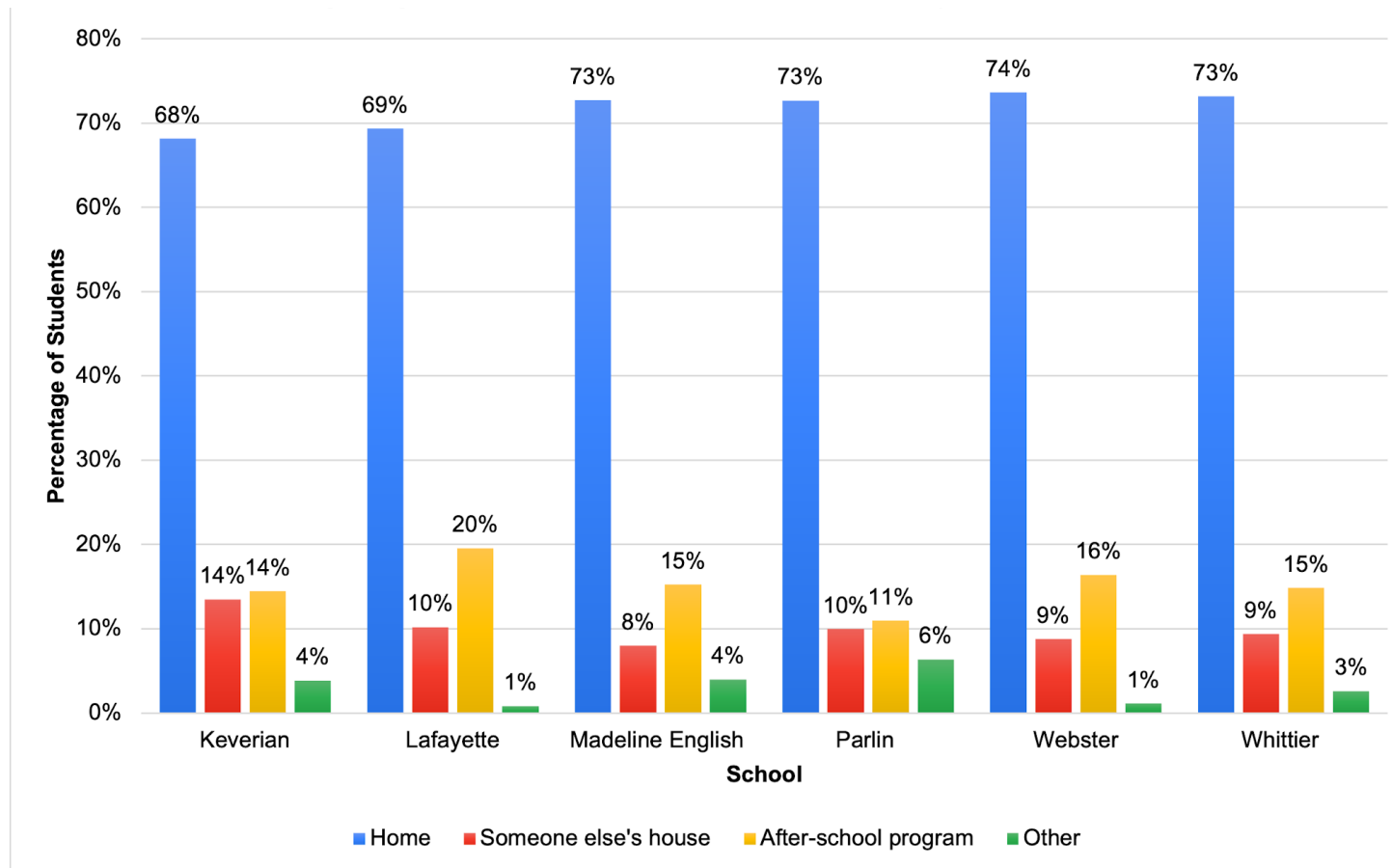


Figure 4D: K-5 Transportation Students Would Like to Try
